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*WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government desires to strengthen the city's resiliency against human induced or natural disasters by recognizing the vision, policy framework and strategies capitalized on disaster risk reduction and management in Quezon City, and which envisages a Quality City with an empowered and responsive citizenry who live in a sustainable, well planned, and structurally sound environment with a vibrant economy under a proactive leadership;*

*WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government intends to comply with the President's directive for national agencies and NCR-LGUs to implement the Two-Pronged Strategy towards a Disaster-Resilient Greater Metro Manila Area (GMMA) and to align the existing Contingency Plans for Earthquake according to the ten (10) Key Result Areas (KRAs) by the National Resilience Team;*

*WHEREAS, Section 12 of Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction Management Act of 2010," requires Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Offices to "Facilitate and support risk assessment and contingency planning activities at the local level";*



NOW, THEREFORE,


