RESOLUTION NO. SP. 7472 , S-2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL PERMIT TO PHIL GRAND IMPERIAL GROUP, INC. TO OPERATE AN ELECTRONIC GAMES OUTLET TO BE LOCATED AT 2/F METROLANE COMPLEX, P. TUAZON BOULEVARD CORNER 20<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE, CUBAO, QUEZON CITY SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR).

Introduced by Councilors ALEXIS R. HERRERA and FRANZ S. PUMAREN.

WHEREAS, Petitioner, Phil Grand Imperial Group, Inc. an entity registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission with Company Registration No. CS201000469 located at Unit 1-E/1-F, 1642 Imperial Bay Front Tower, A. Mabini Street, Malate, Manila City, is applying for a Special Permit to operate an Electronic Gaming outlet to be located at 2/F Metrolane Complex, P. Tuazon Boulevard corner 20th Avenue, Cubac, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to operate an E-Games establishment in Quezon City, there in a need to secure a Special Permit from the City Council pursuant to Ordinance No. SP-2285, S-2014, in relation to the provisions of Republic Act No.7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, Phil Grand Imperial Group, Inc. has complied with the necessary requirements for the issuance of Special Permit as mandated by the aforementioned ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Tagumpay has issued a Barangay Resolution No. 039, S-2018 dated February 3, 2018 for the said project, interposing no objection.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the issuance of a Special Permit to Phil Grand Imperial Group, Inc. to operate an Electronic Gaming outlet at 2/F Metrolane Complex, P. Tuazon Boulevard corner 20th Avenue, Cubao, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by PAGCOR.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the PAGCOR-licensed Phil Grand Imperial Group Inc. shall remit to the City Treasurer's Office a franchise Fee of three percent (3%) of the annual gross administrative and operations commissions, payable annually to the City Treasury during the lifetime of this measure.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the authority herein granted shall be for a period of two (2) years and maybe renewed by the Quezon City Council.
