YLLANA, JR., DISTRICT V - QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (QCG), FOR THE EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION, OPERATION AND MONITORING OF PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS OF THE CITY, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that, "the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance";

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WHEREAS, the Commission on Audit (COA) issued Audit Observation Memorandum 2014-11-C, 2013, "requiring the City Council to give prior authorization to the City Mayor before any expenses/disbursements charged against a lump sum appropriation can be made" citing the case of Hon. Gabriel Quisimbing vs Hon. Gwendolyn F Garcia (GR No175527) of the Supreme Court as basis;

WHEREAS, a request was made by the Quezon City Government (QCG), to procure one (1) unit of motorized vehicle to be utilized for transport of personnel onsite inspections, surveys, research works, meetings, seminars, delivery of communications materials and such other official activities that are necessary for the implementation, operation and monitoring of their respective programs and/or projects;

WHEREAS, the motor vehicle requested shall have the following specifications, to wit:




