RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7535**, S-2018

A RESOLUTION URGING THE QUEZON CITY POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY (QCPU) TO ACCOMPLISH THE REQUIREMENTS FOR RECOGNITION AND ELIGIBILITY FOR FREE HIGHER EDUCATION UNDER REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10931 OR THE UNIVERSAL ACCESS TO QUALITY TERTIARY EDUCATION ACT (UAQTEA) OF 2017.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10931 promotes the universal access to quality tertiary education by providing for free tuition and other school fees in State Universities and Colleges, Local Universities and Colleges and State-Run Technical Vocational Institutions, thereby establishing the Tertiary Education Subsidy and Student Loan Program;

WHEREAS, Section 3 of the same Republic Act states that "the cost of Tertiary Education refers to (1) tuition and other school fees, (2) educational expenses and (3) the cost of living allowance";

WHEREAS, Local Universities and Colleges or LUCs refers to CHED-accredited public Higher Education Institutions established by local government units (LGUs) through an enabling ordinance, financially supported by the LGU concerned, and compliant with the policies, standards, and guidelines of the CHED (Commission on Higher Education);

WHEREAS, Quezon City Polytechnic University as provided for in Ordinance No. SP-1030, S-2001, aims to support the goals and policies of the national government in providing its citizens the needed quality education;

WHEREAS, being recognized as eligible to provide free higher education will ensure that in Quezon City everyone will be given the opportunity to pursue tertiary education and uplift their quality of well-being;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10931 or the Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education Act of 2017, will be fully implemented starting the Academic Year 2018-2019.

NOW, THEREFORE,




