RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7536** S-2018

A RESOLUTION AMENDING SECTION 13 PARAGRAPH 2 AND ADDING LETTER K TO SECTION 8 OF RESOLUTION NO. SP-6824, S-2016, ENTITLED A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE INTERNAL RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE 20<sup>TH</sup> QUEZON CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, Section 15 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that "Every local government unit created or recognized under this Code is a body politic and corporate endowed with powers to be exercised by it in conformity with law. As such, it shall exercise powers as a political subdivision of the National Government and as a corporate entity representing the inhabitants of its territory";

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the same Republic Act provides in part that "every local government unit shall exercise powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary and appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare";

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council has an existing Internal Rules of Procedure adopted by virtue of Resolution No. SP-6824, S-2016;

WHEREAS, there is a need to update the aforesaid rules in order to be responsive to the changing times and needs of this City.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to amend, as it does hereby amend Section 13 paragraph 2 and adding Letter K to Section 8 of Resolution No. SP-6824, S-2016, entitled A Resolution adopting the Internal Rules of Procedure of the 20<sup>th</sup> Quezon City Council.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that Section 13 (3) of Resolution No. SP-6824, S-2016 shall be amended as follows:


COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS – All matters relating to the appropriation of funds for expenditures of the City Government, the payment of public indebtedness, auditing and adjustment of accounts and expenditures, claims against the City Government; and in general, all matters relating to the disbursement of the City Funds. Review and approve jointly with the Committee on Laws, Rules and Internal Government the Annual and Supplemental Budget of all the Barangays and the Sangguniang Kabataan, subject to confirmation by the majority of the Members of the City Council in plenary session.


RESOLVED, FINALLY, that Section 8 (K) of Resolution No. SP-6824, S-2016 shall be added as follows:

k. Acts as the Chairman of the Special Review Committee on Barangay Ordinances created under Resolution No. SP-29, S-92, in relation to Section 57 of Republic Act No. 7160, the Local Government Code of 1991, which is principally tasked to determine whether barangay ordinances and executive orders submitted for review are consistent with law and existing city ordinances and submits its report to the City Council for confirmation/ approval.


