A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. SP-7283, S-2017, BY WAY OF ADJUSTING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY TO BE USED FOR THE MOTOR VEHICLE TO BE PURCHASED BY THE OFFICE OF COUNCILOR ERIC Z. MEDINA FROM ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP1,445,000.00) TO ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED NINETY-TWO THOUSAND PESOS (PHP1,592,000.00), AS WELL AS THE SPECIFICATIONS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Office of Councilor Eric Z. Medina is requesting for the purchase of one (1) unit of motor vehicle intended for the monitoring of programs and projects of the said office;

WHEREAS, in support of the said request, the City Council adopted Resolution No. SP-7283, S-2017, which was Confirmed on December 4, 2017, entitled "A Resolution authorizing the Quezon City Government, through the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to purchase of one (1) unit of motor vehicle intended for the monitoring of programs and projects of the Office of Councilor Eric Z. Medina amounting to One Million Four Hundred Forty Five Thousand Pesos (Php1,445,000.00), to be charged against the available funds of the same office";

WHEREAS, pursuant to DLG Memorandum Circular No. 2014-155 dated December 17, 2014, as amended by Memorandum Circular No. 2017-1 dated April 26, 2017, amending DBM Budget Circular No. 2016-5 dated August 22, 2016, the engine displacement of the subject motor vehicle should not exceed 2400 cc (2.4) for diesel and 2000 for gasoline. Hence, the need to change the unit of motor vehicle to be purchased which concomitantly change the amount and specifications thereof.

WHEREAS, the new specifications of the motor vehicle to be procured are the following:

DVD/USB/iPod/Bluetooth with call  
function and GPS Navigation.

\*Safety includes Driver (w/Knee) and  
Passenger SRS Airbags, ABS (Anti-Lock  
Brake System) with Electronic Brakeforce  
Distribution, ISOFIX with Tether Anchor,  
LED High Mount Stop Lamp, Vehicle  
Security System with Immobilizer + Horn,  
and Back Sensors.

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WHEREAS, Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the City Mayor shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to amend, as it does hereby amend Resolution No. SP-7283, S-2017, by way of adjusting the amount of money to be used for the motor vehicle to be purchased by the Office of Councilor Eric Z. Medina from One Million Four Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Pesos (Php1,445,000.00) to One Million Five Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand Pesos (Php1,592,000.00), as well as the specifications thereof.


