RESOLUTION NO. SP 7545, S 2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION NINE HUNDRED FORTY EIGHT THOUSAND AND FORTY PESOS (PHP2,948,040.00) TO FUND THE PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE QUEZON CITY LADIES FOUNDATION, INC., TO BE TAKEN FROM THE APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS, AIDS AND SUBSIDIES UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR IN THE 2018 ANNUAL BUDGET OF QUEZON CITY OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS.

WHEREAS, its vision is to unite and inspire the women of Quezon City toward achieving the highest ideals of community service;



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista to extend financial assistance in behalf of the Quezon City Government in the amount of Two Million Nine Hundred Forty Eight Thousand and Forty Pesos (PHP2,948,040.00) to fund the projects and activities of the Quezon City Ladies Foundation, Inc., to be taken from the appropriation for Grants, Aids and Subsidies under the Office of the City Mayor in the 2018 Annual Budget of Quezon City or from any available funds.


