RESOLUTION NO. SP. 7562 S-2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (QCG) THROUGH MAYOR HERBERT M BAUTISTA, TO SIGN THE DEED OF DONATION, FOR THE FIVE (5) UNITS OF MOTOR VEHICLES, TO BE UTILIZED BY THE METROPOLITAN MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (MMDA), SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Code of 1991 specifically Section 17 - Basic Services and Facilities.

"(a) Local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall also discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and offices devolved to them pursuant to this Code. Local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provision of the basic services and facilities enumerated herein.";

WHEREAS, as stated under Republic Act No. 7924, entitled: "AN ACT CREATING THE METROPOLITAN MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, DEFINING ITS POWERS AND FUNCTIONS, PROVIDING FUNDING THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES;

Section 1. Declaration of Policy - It is hereby declared to be the policy of the State to treat Metropolitan Manila as a special development and administrative region and certain basic services affecting or involving Metro Manila as metro-wide services more efficiently and effectively planned, supervised and coordinated by a development authority as created therein, without prejudice to the autonomy of the affected local government units. Pursuant to this policy, Metropolitan Manila, as a public corporation created under Presidential Decree No. 824, embracing the Cities of Caloocan, Manila, Mandaluyong, Pasay, and Quezon and the Municipalities of Las Piñas, Makati, Malabon, Marikina, Muntinlupa Navotas, Parañaque, Pasig, Pateros, San Juan, Taguig, and Valenzuela, is hereby constituted into a special development and administered region."

WHEREAS, the MMDA shall perform planning, monitoring and coordinative functions, and in the process exercise regulatory and supervisory authority over the delivery of metro-wide services within Metro Manila without diminution of the autonomy of the local government units concerning purely local matters;

WHEREAS, the donation of the five (5) units of motor vehicles, and its accessories are necessary to provide immediate assistance as well as to inspire and further show the Quezon City Government's support to the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA), to carry out its mandated functions.

## NOW, THEREFORE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the Quezon City Government (QCG), through Mayor Herbert M. Bautista, to sign the Deed of Donation, for the five (5) units of motor vehicles, to be utilized by the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA), subject to existing laws, rules and regulations.
