RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7567**, S-2018

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN MILLION PESOS (P10,000,000.00) IN FAVOR OF THE PROVINCES OF CAGAYAN AND KALINGA, SEVERELY AFFECTED BY TYPHOON "OMPONG" (INTERNATIONAL CODE NAME MANGKHUT) TO BE TAKEN FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY, REALLOCATING FUNDS AND INTENDED USE OF THE AMOUNT, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, Typhoon "Ompong" (International Code Name Mangkhut) claimed dozens of lives and left much damage to properties, public and private in the northern part of the country;

WHEREAS, its ferocious winds toppled electricity posts, causing power outages, intense rain triggered flash floods, forcing people to move to evacuation centers;

WHEREAS, among the hardest hit and devastated by the typhoon in northern Luzon were the provinces of Cagayan and Kalinga;

WHEREAS, the total cost has not been accounted and the death toll, which as of last count stood at 49, has yet to be pegged, but the trail of evidence that the typhoon left behind tells of thousands of lives have been disrupted;


WHEREAS, Section 33 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides for the "cooperative undertaking among local government units by grouping themselves, consolidate or coordinate their efforts, services and resources for the purpose commonly to them, particularly on relief and rescue operation;

WHEREAS, the City Government is empowered under Section 458 (1)(iv) of Republic Act No. 7160, "to adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities and to provide relief services and assistance for the victims during and in the aftermath of disasters and calamities and their return to productive livelihood following such events."


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista to extend financial assistance in the amount of Ten Million Pesos (P10,000,000.00) in favor of the Provinces of Cagayan and Kalinga, severely affected by Typhoon "Ompong" (International Code Name Mangkhut) to be taken from any available funds of the city, reallocating funds and intended use of the amount, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations.
