**A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO FORM A MONITORING TASK FORCE THAT WILL CLOSELY OVERSEE THE ENFORCEMENT OF CITY ORDINANCES ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL.**

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod, as the legislative body of the city, is mandated to approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective city government;

WHEREAS, for the past several years, the City Council has enacted various city ordinances that are truly beneficial and intended to maintain peace and order, preserve cleanliness and beautification, protect the health and safety of the inhabitants, and the like;

WHEREAS, it has been observed, however, that despite the passage and existence of the said ordinances, there are still an apparent violations thereof;

WHEREAS, under Section 389 (b)(1) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Punong Barangay is mandated to "enforce all laws and ordinances which are applicable within the barangay";

WHEREAS, the members of police force are likewise duty-bound to enforce the said laws and ordinances for the purpose of ensuring tranquility and maintaining peace and order in their place of assignment;

WHEREAS, with the establishment or formation of the Monitoring Task Force, who will coordinate with the barangay, the police authorities, and other law enforcement agencies, the implementation of city ordinances could be closely monitored and the welfare of the city inhabitants properly addressed;


WHEREAS, the Honorable City Mayor, as the Local Chief Executive, may be able to convene the different offices and departments of the Quezon City Government for the purpose of giving life to the said task force.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to form a Monitoring Task Force that will closely oversee the enforcement of city ordinances enacted by the City Council.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Office of the City Mayor for their information and appropriate action.


