**A RESOLUTION URGING THE SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICE AND THE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO ESTABLISH PROTOCOLS IN THE TRANSPORT TO PUBLIC AND/OR PRIVATE HOSPITALS OF PATIENTS IN EMERGENCY CONDITIONS.**

*WHEREAS, according to the records of the Center for Health Development of the Department of Health, the Quezon City has 58 licensed hospitals with a combined bed capacity of 8,655. Forty-two (42) are privately owned and sixteen (16) are government-owned. Four of these hospitals are internationally accredited and certified;*

*WHEREAS, given the volume of available hospitals in our City, this Resolution urges both the Schools Division Office and the City Health Department to establish efficient transport protocols of patients under emergency conditions, taking into consideration time and distance;*

*WHEREAS, this Resolution aims to prevent the re-occurrence of a tragic incident in 2017 where an overhanging branch fell and took the life of a Grade 1 public school pupil in Quezon City.*



NOW, THEREFORE.


