RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7594**, S-2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (PHP1,500,000.00) TO FUND THE PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE QUEZON CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS ASSOCIATION (QCPSTA) FOR THE YEAR 2018 TO BE TAKEN FROM THE APPROPRIATION OF GRANTS, AID AND SUBSIDIES UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR IN THE 2018 ANNUAL BUDGET OF QUEZON CITY OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the QCPSTA is the official and duly recognized organization of teachers and non-teaching personnel under the Division of City Schools-Quezon City, Philippines. The QCPSTA is recognized by the Philippine Public School Teachers Association as their local affiliated chapter and the QCPSTA President, Mabelle D. Caboboy is a regular member of the Quezon City Local School Board. The QCPSTA is also an affiliated chapter of the Alliance of Concerned Teachers (ACT). ACT is a member of Education International (EI);

WHEREAS, the QCPSTA has a total number of Sixteen Thousand Five Hundred (16,500) members, this includes all the teaching and non-teaching personnel;

WHEREAS, the QCPSTA has a total number of One Hundred Forty-Three (143) members-schools, comprising of Ninety-Seven (97) Elementary Schools and Forty-Six (46) High Schools; \*

WHEREAS, the QCPSTA's declared principles and objectives are to promote the rights and welfare of public school teachers and employees and work for an educational system that contributes to the realization of a just, free, democratic, peaceful and prosperous Philippines;


WHEREAS, the QCPSTA has an on-going welfare benefit projects such as The QCPSTA Death Aid Contribution System (DACS), Free Annual Medical Check-Up, Rice Subsidy Allowance, Retired Teachers Medical Assistance Program and Medical Assistance Fund for Seriously Ill Members;

WHEREAS, in order to fulfill their mandate and defray the cost of annual medical examination of their members as well as other major activities of the organization, there is a need to fund the administrative and activity expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to extend financial assistance in behalf of the Quezon City Government in the amount of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php1,500,000.00) to fund the projects and activities of the Quezon City Public School Teachers Association (QCPSTA) for the year 2018 to be taken from the appropriation of grants, aids and subsidies under the Office of the City Mayor in the 2018 Annual Budget of Quezon City or from any available funds.


