WHEREAS, the 2018 Asian Games, officially known as the 18th Asian Games Jakarta Palembang 2018, is a Pan Continental Multi-Sport event held every four years among athletes from all over Asia;

WHEREAS, the 18th Asian Games was held from 18 August to 02 September 2018, with forty-five (45) participating nations, with 462 events in sixty-one (61) sports/disciplines;

WHEREAS, the theme, "Energy of Asia", was about radiating the multinational cultural nature of Asia;

WHEREAS, Hidilyn Diaz, gave the country its first gold medal, through the Women's Weightlifting 53-kg event, at the Jakarta International Expo Hall A on Tuesday, August 21; †

WHEREAS, two (2) silver medals were given to the country by Kiyomi Watanabe through the Women's Judo 63-kg event and Rogan Ladon through the Men's Flyweight 52-kg Boxing event on August 30 and September 1, respectively;

7. Daniel Caluag through Men's Cycling BMX race on August 25;
8. Jefferson Rhey Loon through Men's Pencak Silat class D 60-65 kg on August 26;
9. Dines Dumaan through Men's Pencak Silat class B 50-55 kg on August 26;
10. Bianca Pagdangananun through Women's Individual Golf on August 26;


