RESOLUTION NO. SP- 7608 S-2018

A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF TOPNOTCH BINGO TREND, INC. TO OPERATE AN ELECTRONIC BINGO (E-BINGO) ESTABLISHMENT AT NO. 94 TIMOG AVENUE, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR).

Introduced by Councilor IVY XENIA L. LAGMAN.

WHEREAS, Topnotch Bingo Trend, Inc., a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office at No. 94 Timog Avenue, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to operate an Electronic Bingo (E-Bingo) establishment in Quezon City, there is a need to secure a Special Permit from the City Council pursuant to Ordinance No. SP-2285, S-2014, in relation to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, Topnotch Bingo Trend, Inc. is earnestly requesting the City Council to renew the Special Permit to operate an E-Bingo establishment;

WHEREAS, the operation of E-Bingo Machines is regulated and licensed by the PAGCOR;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid business activity will provide employment and additional revenue to the City Government, thereby boosting the city's economy.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew the Special Permit of Topnotch Bingo Trend, Inc. to operate an Electronic Bingo (E-Bingo) establishment at No. 94 Timog Avenue, Quezon City, subject to the Rules and Regulations Promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that Topnotch Bingo Trend, Inc. shall remit to the City Treasurer's Office a franchise fee of three percent (3%) of the gross revenue of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasury during the lifetime of this measure.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the authority herein granted shall be for a period of two (2) years and maybe renewed by the City Council.
