RESOLUTION NO. SP- 7614, S-2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO PROCURE FIVE (5) UNITS OF MOTORIZED VEHICLE, TO BE UTILIZED AND DIVIDED FOR THE OFFICE OF COUNCILOR ANDRES JOSE G. YLLANA, JR. FOUR (4) UNITS AND COUNCILOR IVY XENIA L. LAGMAN ONE (1) UNIT, FOR THE EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION, OPERATION AND MONITORING OF PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS OF THEIR RESPECTIVE JURISDICTION, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that, "the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance";

WHEREAS, the Commission on Audit (COA) issued Audit Observation Memorandum 2014-11-C, S-2013, "requiring the City Council to give prior authorization to the City Mayor before any expenses/disbursements charged against a lump sum appropriation can be made" citing the case of Hon. Gabriel Quisumbing vs Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia (GR No. 175527) decided by the Supreme Court as basis;

WHEREAS, a request was made by the Quezon City Government (QCG), to procure five (5) units of motorized vehicle to be utilized for transport of personnel on-site inspections, surveys, research works, meetings, seminar, delivery of communications, materials and such other official activities that are necessary for the implementation, operation and monitoring of their respective programs and/or projects;

WHEREAS, the motor vehicle requested shall have the following specifications, to wit:

PROJECT TITLE: Five (5) units of motorized vehicle (AUV)

Specifications: Displacement: 2,477cc; Engine Type: 4D56, 2.5 in-line diesel fed; Overall Length: 4,100mm; Overall Width: 1,695mm; Overall Height: 1,795mm; Wheelbase: 2,200mm; No of Cylinder: 4; Payload: 1,045kg; Maximum power: 70.72PS/4,200rpm; Transmission: 5-speed manual; Suspension (front): Coil Spring w/ stabilizer; Suspension (rear): leaf spring; Breaks: Front disc, rear drums; Wheels: 14"x50J steel rims; Tires: 185R, 14C 8PR; Seating Capacity: 15 persons; Aircon System: Dual; Accessories: Sunshade (Tint) Matting, EWD; Warranty Accessories: Three years/ 100,000 kms; free LTO registration process to red plate with TPL Insurance.

Budget Allocation: PhP1,000,000.00 (per unit) x Five (5)
Units = Php5,000,000.00




