RESOLUTION NO. SP- 7632, S-2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ENTER INTO A TRIPARTITE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN LION'S PRESIDENT LEAGUE OF THE PHILIPPINES (LPLP) REPRESENTED BY ITS PRESIDENT, DR. LAURO I. FELICIANO AND BARANGAY MARIANA, REPRESENTED BY ITS PUNONG BARANGAY REGINA CELESTE C. SAN MIGUEL TO ALLOW THE FORMER TO CONTINUALLY USE AND CONDUCT LIVELIHOOD TRAININGS AT THE NEWLY BUILT TWO (2)-STOREY BARANGAY MARIANA TRAINING CENTER.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is the legal and registered owner of the open space along New Jersey Street, between 3rd and 4th Street, Barangay Mariana containing a total area of 3,712 square meters which was donated by Magdalena Estate, Inc. for the residents of Mariana; y

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government has recently constructed a two (2)-storey Barangay Mariana Training Center with bleachers upon the request of Barangay Mariana as the venue of free livelihood training for the public;

WHEREAS, Barangay Mariana would like to provide free, continuous education and livelihood and skills training to its residents, and the general public as well, as to alleviate poverty, enhance a marketable skills of its beneficiaries as its contribution to nation building;

WHEREAS, the Lion's Presidents League of the Philippines has made its representations with Barangay Mariana and Quezon City Government to allow them to continue their advocacy of providing free livelihood and skills training in the Barangay Mariana Training Center. This is in lieu of the demolished LPLP-TESDA facility constructed by the LPLP in 1970s in the same site of the newly built center;

WHEREAS, Barangay Mariana, through its Resolution No. 117, S-2017, recognizes the importance of the people's partnership participation of the LPLP with the livelihood training activities, hence, they are willing to assign the first and second floor of the said Training Center to the LPP, excluding the one (1) room, shower and toilet at the back of the center;

WHEREAS, an authority to sign by the City Mayor from the Sanggunian is required pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, a copy of the Memorandum of Agreement was attached in this resolution and will be made as an integral part hereof. *†*




