RESOLUTION NO. SP- 7633, S-2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT THROUGH THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA TO GRANT AN ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTAL ALLOWANCE OF FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (PHP500.00) EACH TO NATIONAL PAID PERMANENT TEACHING AND NON-TEACHING PERSONNEL OF THE SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICE IN QUEZON CITY FOR THE MONTHS OF JUNE 2018 TO SEPTEMBER 2018.

WHEREAS, Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, authorizes the local government units to provide adequate support to efficient and effective provision of basic services such as education;

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a)(1)(viii) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to "determine the positions and the salaries, wages, allowances and other emoluments and benefits of officials and employees paid wholly or mainly from city funds and provide for expenditures necessary for the proper conduct of programs, projects, services, and activities of the city government";


WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Local Government unit of Quezon City to promote and improve the social and economic status of its public school teaching and non-teaching personnel;


