RESOLUTION NO. SP- 7647, S-2018

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE DEED OF DONATION ENTERED INTO AND SIGNED BY THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (QCG), THROUGH MAYOR HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, FOR THE FORTY-SIX (46) UNITS OF AMBULANCE, TO BE DONATED AND UTILIZED BY THE VARIOUS BARANGAYS OF QUEZON CITY AND THE QUEZON CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICE (QCDRRMO), SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Code of 1991 specifically, Section 17 - Basic Services and Facilities:

- (a) Local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall also discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and offices devolved to them pursuant to this Code. Local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provision of the basic services and facilities enumerated herein;

WHEREAS, the City Government is empowered under Section 447 (1)(iv) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, to "Adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the municipality from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and their return to productive livelihood following said events";

WHEREAS, the various barangays of Quezon City and the QC Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (QCDRRMO) share a common objective: "to provide quality service which will make Quezon City an ideal community where people live, work and do business in a hospitable, progressive and peaceful environment";

WHEREAS, the donation of the Forty Six (46) units of Ambulance and its accessories are necessary to provide immediate assistance as well as to inspire and further show the Quezon City Government's support to various barangays of Quezon City and the QC Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (QCDRRMO);

WHEREAS, as a sign of sincere token of the Quezon City Government through Mayor Herbert M. Bautista's support to the Barangays of Quezon City, to their respective jurisdiction and the QC Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (QCDRRMO)'s to attain their mandated function.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to ratify, as it does hereby ratify the Deed of Donation entered into and signed by the Quezon City Government (QCG), through Mayor Herbert M. Bautista, for the forty-six (46) units of Ambulance, to be donated and utilized by the various barangays of Quezon City and the Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (QCDRRMO), subject to existing laws, rules and regulations. y


