A RESOLUTION URGING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT TO GRANT ALLOWANCE INCREASE TO QUEZON CITY POLICE DISTRICT PERSONNEL, TO BE TAKEN FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE EXISTING POLICIES, RULES AND REGULATIONS.


