RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7708**, S-2019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, QUEZON CITY, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OF TEN THOUSAND PESOS (PHP10,000.00) TO EACH OF THE TWO HUNDRED ONE (201) CENSUSED FAMILIES OF ENLISTED PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) PERSONNEL RESIDING INSIDE CAMP PANOPIO IN BARANGAY KAUNLARAN, QUEZON CITY, WHO WILL BE AFFECTED BY THE SITE CLEARING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROPOSED PNP MEDICAL PLAZA AND OTHER FACILITIES INSIDE CAMP PANOPIO, AND WHO ARE ABOUT TO BE RELOCATED TO NATIONAL HOUSING AUTHORITY (NHA) RESETTLEMENT SITE IN ANTIPOLO CITY, PROVINCE OF RIZAL, EQUIVALENT TO A TOTAL AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION TEN THOUSAND PESOS (PHP2,010,000.00).

WHEREAS, a total of two hundred one (201) censused families of enlisted Philippine National Police (PNP) personnel and members of the Enlisted Men's Barrio Panopio Compound Neighborhood Association, Inc. (EMBPCNAI) residing inside Camp Panopio in Barangay Kaunlaran are about to be affected by the clearing of the site for the development and construction of the proposed PNP Medical Plaza and other facilities inside Camp Panopio

WHEREAS, the National Housing Authority has approved a relocation allocation for the qualified members of EMBPCNAI in its resettlement site at Virgen Dela Paz, Barangay San Jose, Antipolo City, Province of Rizal;

WHEREAS, the EMBPCNAI, in a letter of its president, Engr. Eugerly O. Encarnacion, has requested financial assistance from the Quezon City Government;


WHEREAS, to draw cooperation from the affected families of enlisted PNP personnel residing inside Camp Panopio and also to provide them with something to start with at the resettlement site, there is a need for the Quezon City Government to allocate and extend financial assistance to the 201 affected families in the total amount of Php 2,010,000.00 or an equivalent amount of Ten Thousand Pesos (Php 10,000.00) per family;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to extend financial assistance of Ten Thousand Pesos (Php10,000.00) to each of the two hundred one (201) censused families of enlisted Philippine National Police (PNP) personnel residing inside Camp Panopio in Barangay Kaunlaran, Quezon City, who will be affected by the site clearing for the construction of the proposed PNP Medical Plaza and other facilities inside Camp Panopio, and who are about to be relocated to National Housing Authority (NHA) resettlement site in Antipolo City, Province of Rizal, equivalent to a total amount of Two Million Ten Thousand Pesos (Php2,010,000.00)
