A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO SIGN THE DEEDS OF DONATION IN FAVOR OF THE THIRTY EIGHT (38) BARANGAYS OF DISTRICT IV, THIS CITY, FOR THE DONATION OF THIRTY-EIGHT (38) EMERGENCY RESCUE VEHICLES, AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF THE SAME TO THE RECIPIENTS WITHOUT COST.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the General Welfare Clause, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991, every local government unit within their respective territorial jurisdictions is empowered, among others, to maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, in living up to this mandate, the barangays have been the cornerstone in maintaining peace and order in the community, as well as our first responders on occasions of emergency and calamity; †

WHEREAS, to support the barangays, especially those in District IV, in the performance of their duties and functions, it will be important therefore to provide them with emergency rescue vehicles that will serve their residents;

WHEREAS, the specifications of the said emergency rescue vehicles are as follows:

Fuel Tank Capacity: 46 liters; Single Aircon System; Dual Airbags;
8-passengers; Overall Length: 4,155mm; Overall Width: 1,655mm;
Overall Height: 1,865mm; Ground Clearance: 1700mm;
Outside Body Dimension: 7ft x 5 inches (L) x 5 ft& 6 inches (W) x
5 ft (H);

INCLUSIONS

Emergency LED light bar with siren;
Metal axe; Plastic Stretcher; and Blood Pressure Monitor

WHEREAS, to efficiently utilize these vehicles, the same shall be donated to the thirty-eight (38) barangays in District IV through Deeds of Donation, thereby transferring ownership, as well as maintenance and other related expenses for their use. *A* *D* *D*


