RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7716**, S-2019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE CITY MAYOR OF ANTIPOLO CITY, HONORABLE CASIMIRO A. YNARES III, NATIONAL HOUSING AUTHORITY, REPRESENTED BY ITS GENERAL MANAGER MARCELINO P. ESCALADA JR., AND THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE, REPRESENTED BY QUEZON CITY POLICE DISTRICT DIRECTOR PCSUPT. JOSELITO T. ESQUIVEL JR., FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE OFF-CITY RESETTLEMENT SITE, INTENDED FOR THE RELOCATION OF THE 201 CENSUSED FAMILIES OF ENLISTED PNP PERSONNEL WHO WILL BE AFFECTED BY THE SITE CLEARING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROPOSED PNP MEDICAL PLAZA AND OTHER FACILITIES INSIDE CAMP PANOPIO.

WHEREAS, as embodied in Executive Order No. 90 dated December 17, 1966, the National Housing Authority (NHA) is the sole national government agency engaged in housing production mandated to meet the housing needs of low-income earners, particularly the lowest thirty percent (30%) of the urban population;

WHEREAS, a Local Government Inter-Agency Committee (LIAC) was created for the relocation of the two hundred one (201) families of Retired PNP Personnel residing inside Camp Panopio, a National Police Camp situated in Barangay Kaunlaran, Quezon City, which will undergo clearing of the Camp of housing facilities to give way for the construction of PNP Hospital and other PNP facilities;

WHEREAS, in order to implement the aforementioned projects, the PNP has requested the NHA to allocate 201 housing units in any of its present resettlement sites;

WHEREAS, the NHA, one of the members of the LIAC, has approved the allocation of 201 housing units in its resettlement site situated in Virgen Dela Paz, Barangay San Jose, Antipolo City, Rizal;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Antipolo City (LGU-AC), in support of the resettlement program for the censused families of Retired PNP Personnel inside Camp Panopio, has agreed to accommodate and receive the 201 affected families to NHA Resettlement Site situated within its territorial jurisdiction, particularly the NHA Resettlement Site at Virgen Dela Paz, Barangay San Jose, Antipolo City, Rizal;

WHEREAS, pending the availability and provision of the complete basic services for the relocated families of Retired PNP Personnel as mandated under the Resettlement Program of the National Government, the Local Government Unit of Quezon City (LGU-QC), as the sending LGU has agreed to provide a financial assistance fund to LGU-AC in the amount of Ten Million Pesos (Php10,000,000.00);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, the subject MOA shall become effective upon the ratification of the Quezon City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the City Mayor of Antipolo City, Honorable Casimiro A. Ynares III, National Housing Authority, represented by its General Manager Marcelino P. Escalada Jr., and Philippine National Police, represented by Quezon City Police District Director PCSupt. Joselito T. Esquivel Jr., for the development of the off-city resettlement site, intended for the relocation of the 201 censused families of enlisted PNP personnel who will be affected by the site clearing for the construction of the proposed PNP Medical Plaza and other facilities inside Camp Panopio and as the sending LGU, Quezon City Government has agreed to provide a financial assistance fund to LGU-AC in the amount of Ten Million Pesos (Php10,000,000.00).
