WHEREAS, the Taga-Alog 2018, Ilog Pasig: Balik Tanaw, Balik Sigla, is a creative campaign for the promotion of Pasig River as a space for cultural identity and collective memory. The campaign is spearheaded by the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), and implemented by the Philippine Educational Theater Association (PETA), recipient of the 2017 Ramon Magsaysay Award. It aims to pay homage to the great river by harnessing its rich stories that reflect our traditions, history, culture, heritage and ways of life and using the arts in retelling these stories;

WHEREAS, the project offers art-based activities like workshops, arts events and happenings, research and conference, performances, festivals, and experiential tours. These arts explorations in music, dance, theater, film, performance arts, and creative writing were conducted in the cities around the Pasig River and its tributaries: Manila, Mandaluyong, San Juan, Makati, Pasig and Marikina;

WHEREAS, the programs are: *TampisAWIT* (a songwriting workshop and competition), *LikhAGOS* (a creative writing workshop and competition), *WISIK*, mga kwentong siksik (a short film workshop and competition), *DramAHON* (a performance workshop and competition), *IndakPATAK* (a dance workshop), *Lakbay Baybay* (experiential tours), and *Lagaslas* (online and print publications);

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Quezon City enacted SP-2756, S-2018, establishing the *Lucrecia R. Kasilag Senior High School*, in honor of *Lucrecia R. Kasilag*, a National Artist for Music;

WHEREAS, *Lucrecia R. Kasilag Senior High School* was awarded the Grand Winner of *Taga-Alog 2018*, *Ilog Pasig: Balik Tanaw*, *Balik Sigla*, *Dramahon* category, on December 5, 2018;


WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government recognizes the importance of preserving, promoting and popularizing cultural and heritage treasures to increase the awareness of local residents and visitors to a place's history and instill among them a sense of patriotism, pride and love. ↑
