A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. SP-6797, S-2016, AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, THROUGH THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA TO PURCHASE SIX (6) UNITS OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO BE DONATED AND THE OWNERSHIP THEREOF TRANSFERRED TO FIVE (5) PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS AND ONE (1) UNIT FOR QCPD POLICE STATION 3, ALL OF DISTRICT VI, QUEZON CITY, TO BE CHARGED TO THE OFFICE OF COUNCILOR MARIVIC CO-PILAR.

WHEREAS, the Public High Schools in District VI, Quezon City in cooperation with the Office of City Councilor Marivic Co-Pilar, has been indispensable partners in the implementation of the education programs of the latter;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Police Station 3 is the primary entity mandated by law to protect the welfare of the people and pursuant to the mandate of President Rodrigo R. Duterte of the Republic of the Philippines, to continuously and vigorously strengthen and maintain peace and order in the 6th District of Quezon City. It is the primary partner of Councilor Marivic Co-Pilar in her programs for peace and order and protection of the public welfare in the 6th District;

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WHEREAS, the Office of City Councilor Marivic Co-Pilar through Resolution No. SP- 6797, which authorized Quezon City Government through Mayor Herbert M. Bautista to purchase six (6) units of motor vehicle to be donated and the ownership thereof transferred to the five (5) Public High Schools and One (1) unit for QCPD Police Station 3 of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, to enhance the efficiency in assisting the Office of City Councilor Marivic Co-Pilar and the Quezon City Government in their programs of maintaining peace and order, further protecting the public welfare, the Quezon City Police Station 3 and its officers will be receiving from the local government of Quezon City, with the authorization of the City Council, through the Honorable City Mayor, Herbert M. Bautista, one (1) unit of motor vehicle with the specifications attached herewith, without cost;

WHEREAS, to give ease, improve mobility and so that educational programs and projects of City Councilor Marivic Co-Pilar and the Local Government of Quezon City would reach every citizen of the 6th District of Quezon City, with authorization from the City Council and through the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, Public High Schools in the 6th District will be receiving five (5) units of motor vehicles with the specifications attached herewith, without cost.

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
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
NOW, THEREFORE,


