WHEREAS, Claret School of Quezon City, also known colloquially as Claret, is a private Catholic elementary and secondary institution located at Mahinhin Street, Barangay Teachers Village West, Quezon City. It was established in June 1967, and founded and run by Claretian missionaries. The school was named after its patron saint, Anthony Mary Claret, who founded the Congregation of the Missionary Sons of the Immaculate Heart of Mary in 1849;

WHEREAS, during the 15th Del Monte Football Cup held on April 5-6, 2019 at Camp Phillips, Bukidnon, Claret Red Roosters Restore Football Pride won the Championship for Category Boys 18;

WHEREAS, the said competition, which aims to develop sportsmanship and football skills of the youth, was participated by twenty (20) football clubs from different parts of the country;

WHEREAS, prior to this competition, members from Claret Red Roosters Restore Football Pride together with players from Ateneo de Manila University represented Team Quezon City for the Palarong Pambansa qualifier; however, the team missed the chance to represent NCR in the Palarong Pambansa after a nail-biting match against Team Manila in the finals;

WHEREAS, in 2017, NCR Football Team, which consisted of some players of Claret Football Club, won the championship (secondary division) after beating Western Visayas Football Team in the 60th Palarong Pambansa in Antique;

WHEREAS, Claret Red Roosters by far remains as one of the best football teams in the country, as it is consistently ranked among the top football clubs from category under 7 years old to category under 17 years old;

WHEREAS, Claret Red Roosters Restore Football Pride is worthy of Quezon City's commendation as it develops young talents who will be the next generation of football athletes that will someday be representing our country in local and international competitions.


