A RESOLUTION URGING THE HEADS OF THE BUSINESS PERMITS AND LICENSING DEPARTMENT (BPLD) AND THE QUEZON CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT (QCHD) TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT QUEZON CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-1313, S-2003.

WHEREAS, on September 2, 2003 the City Council has enacted Ordinance No. SP-1313, S-2003, entitled:

"An Ordinance requiring commercial/business establishments, carinderias, restaurants, recreation centers and the like, within Quezon City to install partitions in between urinary bowls for male patrons and the imposition of penalties therefor."

which was approved on October 8, 2003 by then City Mayor, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr.;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the said partition between urinary bowls in the toilets are to prevent or avoid nuisance, utter interference with one's privacy, and protect public health;

WHEREAS, while some business establishments and commercial buildings are complying with the provisions of the said ordinance, there are owners, proprietors or managers of said business/commercial activities who are willfully disobeying or are not complying with the same;
