RESOLUTION NO. SP. 8906, S-2022

A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF TOTAL GAMEZONE XTREME, INC. TO OPERATE A TRADITIONAL BINGO, ELECTRONIC BINGO (E-BINGO) AND ELECTRONIC GAMES (E-GAMES) AT THE 2ND FLOOR OF BANAWE CENTER, NO. 238 BANAWE STREET, BARANGAY MANRESA, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR).

WHEREAS, Total Gamezone Xtreme, Inc. is a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with business address at the 2nd Floor of Banawe Center, No. 238 Banawe Street, Barangay Manresa, District I, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Total Gamezone Xtreme Inc. is primarily engaged in the business of Traditional Bingo, Electronic Bingo (E-Bingo) and Electronic Games (E-Games);

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to operate a Traditional Bingo and Electronic Bingo (E-Bingo) and Electronic Games (E-Games) in Quezon City, there is a need to secure a Special Permit from the City Council pursuant to existing ordinance in relation to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, Total Gamezone Xtreme, Inc. is requesting the City Council for the renewal of a Special Permit to Traditional Bingo, Electronic Bingo (E-Bingo) and Electronic Games (E-Games).
