RESOLUTION NO. SP-**8930**, S-2022

A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF BINGO PARADISE INC. TO OPERATE ELECTRONIC BINGO (E-BINGO), TRADITIONAL BINGO AND ELECTRONIC GAMES (E-GAMES) AT 2/F METROLANE COMPLEX, P. TUAZON STREET CORNER 20TH AVENUE, PROJECT 4, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR).

WHEREAS, Bingo Paradise Inc. is a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with business address at 2/F Metrolane Complex, P. Tuazon Street corner 20th Avenue, Project 4, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Bingo Paradise Inc. is primarily engaged in the business of Electronic Bingo (E-Bingo), Traditional Bingo and Electronic Games (E-Games);

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to operate Electronic Bingo (E-Bingo), Traditional Bingo and Electronic Games (E-Games) in Quezon City, there is a need to secure a Special Permit from the City Council pursuant to existing ordinance in relation to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, Bingo Paradise Inc. is requesting the City Council to renew the Special Permit granted for the operation of Electronic Bingo (E-Bingo), Traditional Bingo and Electronic Bingo (E-Bingo).
