SISTER CITY COOPERATION

The City Government of
GENERAL SANTOS CITY
and The City Government of
QUEZON CITY
herein after referred to as the
"PARTIES"

Desiring to promote favorable relation of partnership and cooperation between the people of the two cities:

HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE - 1

The parties shall establish a Sister City Cooperation to promote and expand an effective and mutually beneficial cooperation in the development of both Cities. Within the limits of their financial, technical capabilities in the following sectors:

1. ENVIRONMENT
2. HUMAN RESOURCES AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
3. SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY
4. EDUCATION & SPORTS
5. TOURISM DEVELOPMENT
6. TRADE: and
7. OTHER SECTORS THAT SHALL BE MUTUALLY

AGREED UPON BY THE PARTIES

ARTICLE - 2

To facilitate the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding the Parties may conclude arrangement within the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding which will cover the fields of activities provided in Article 1.

ARTICLE - 3

A Joint Policy Committee shall be established to oversee the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding. It shall be composed of three (3) representatives from the local Government of Quezon City and three representatives from the local Government of General Santos City. The Joint Policy Committee shall be assisted by a Technical Working Group which shall be established by both Cities.

ARTICLE - 4

The Joint Policy Committee shall meet annually alternatively in General Santos City or Quezon City. If it cannot be held due to certain circumstances. Documents will be exchanged in lieu of such meeting.

ARTICLE - 5

Differences arising out of the interpretation or implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably by consultation or negotiation between both Parties.

ARTICLE - 6

This Memorandum of Understanding may be modified by mutual consent between the Parties and such modification has to be in writing.

ARTICLE - 7


a. This Memorandum of Understanding shall come into force on the date of its signing shall be in force twenty five (25) years unless it is rescinded in writing by either Party giving six (months) notice in advance to the other Party.

b. Should this Memorandum of Understanding be terminated the arrangements agreed upon by the Parties shall remain in force until such a time when the implementation of the series of activities has been carried out to its completion.
