ORDINANCE NO. NG- 48, 2-88

ORDINANCE

ORDAINING PREFERENTIAL RIGHT TO REGISTERED VOTERS OF QUEZON CITY TO BE EMPLOYED AND/OR HIRED IN INFRA-STRUCTURE CONSTRUCTIONS AND BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS IN QUEZON CITY.

Introduced by Councillor Isidro R. Saludes

SECTION 1. Registered voters of Quezon City have preferential right to be employed and/or hired in infrastructure constructions and in private business establishments in Quezon City, except in positions which are highly confidential, highly technical, and requiring special skills in all forms of arts, sciences, technology, and private security guards.


SEC. 2. Preferential right shall mean that among several applicants for the same position, all things being equal, the registered voters in Quezon City shall have preferential right for said employment.

SEC. 3. All such employees and workers who may be hired or employed as ordained in Section 1 hereof shall be registered by the employer with the Office of the City Mayor for statistical purposes.

SEC. 4. Violation of this Ordinance shall cause the imposition of a fine of not more than P1,000.00.

SEC. 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


