ORDINANCE

ORDAINING THE DECLARATION AND RESERVATION OF THAT AREA KNOWN AS THE PLANNED UNIT OF DEVELOPMENT (PUD) AREA, AS SOCIALIZED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY FACILITIES SITE FOR THE DISLOCATED FAMILIES AFFECTED BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CIRCUMFERENTIAL ROAD (C-5) WITHIN BARANGAY ESCOPA, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR ITS (PUD) FINANCING AND DEVELOPMENT.


WHEREAS, the Escopa Urban Development Program in Barangay Escopa, Project 4, Quezon City, includes among other projects the relocation of some four hundred (400) families dislocated by the construction of the circumferential road (C-5) within the boundaries of said Barangay;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government has acquired a 4.4486 - hectare parcel of land adjacent to DSSD which is now the PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (PUD) site designed to provide low-cost housing units and community facilities to meet the needs of the Escopa community;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. That area consisting of 4.4486 hectares of land which was acquired by the City Government and designated as Planned Unit Development (PUD) site under the Escopa Urban Development Program, more specifically bounded and described



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
