APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P750,000.00), OR SO MUCH AS MAY HE REQUIRED, FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE CITY TREASURY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SECOND FLOOR ON THE EXISTING ONESTOREY KAUNLARAN HEALTH CENTER TO BE USED AS A MULTI-PURPOSE BARANGAY HALL.

There is hereby appropriated out of any available funds from the City Treasury the amount of Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P750,000.00) for the construction of a second floor on the existing one-storey Kaunlaran Health Center to be used as a Multi-Purpose Hall.
