Be it ordained by the City Council of Queson City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. A seal showing the Coat of Arms of Quezon City enclosed by a circle wherein the werds SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD, LUNGSOD QUEZON are inscribed and the year 1939 indicated below the Coat of Arms, is hereby adopted as the official seal of the City Council of Quezon City.

One hereof shall be kept by the City Secretary who shall cause the same to be stamped on all ordinances, resolutions and other official papers and documents of the City Council.

SECTION 3. The unauthorized use of the official seal herein above provided by persons other than the official keeper thereof for unlawful purposes shall be punishable by imprisonment for a period of not in excess of ten (10) days of arrests menor or a fine not exceeding ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00), or both such imprisonment and fine in the discretion of the court.
