ORDINANCE

APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 4, GENERAL FUND, IN THE AMOUNT OF EIGHTY MILLION SEVENTY-THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN PESOS (P80,073,547.00) AND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 3, INFRASTRUCTURE FUND, IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION SIXTY THOUSAND PESOS (P3,060,000.00), SERIES OF 1989, TO COVER VARIOUS EXPENSES OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT, AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS THEREFOR.

Introduced by the Committee on Appropriations,
Committee on Laws, Rules and Internal Government and the Committee on Ways & Means.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Supplemental Budget No. 4, General Fund, in the amount of Eighty Million Seventy-Three Thousand Five Hundred Forty-Seven Pesos (P80,073,547.00) and Supplemental Budget No. 3, Infrastructure Fund, in the amount of Three Million Sixty Thousand Pesos (P3,060,000.00), series of 1989, for a total of Eighty-Three Million One Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Forty-Seven Pesos (P83,133,547.00) covering various expenses of the Quezon City Government as per attached documents which are made as integral part hereof, are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the City Treasury of the Quezon City Government the sum of Eighty-Three Million One Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Forty-Seven Pesos (P83,133,547.00) to cover the various expenses provided for in Section 1 hereof, said appropriations to be funded as per attached certification of the City Treasurer which certification is made an integral part hereof.

SECTION 3. The amount of Forty-Four Million Seventy Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-One Pesos (P44,070,871.00) as provided for under and captioned as "Salary Adjustment Fund" in Supplemental Budget No. 4, General Funds, documents shall cover the salary differentials of city employees entitled thereto pursuant to and in implementation of RA 6758; Provided, That the position of Chief of Division, just like Clerk positions, shall be classified into four (4) categories, namely: Chief of Division I, Chief of Division II, Chief of Division III and Chief of Division IV, with at least one (1) salary grade separating one category from the other; and Provided, Finally, That to qualify under category IV, the Division concerned must have at least four (4) or more
