WHEREAS, the City Government of Quezon City, fully cognizant of its moral and legal duties as well as the imperativeness of youth development and his treatment and rehabilitation from drug addiction, deems it fitting and necessary to establish a center to address these areas of vital concern;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Anti-Drug Council had launched a massive campaign to awaken awareness on the perils of the use of prohibited drugs, and was successful in the implementation of its antidrug preventive program;

WHEREAS, through the encouragement of the Quezon City Anti-Drug Abuse Council, and as a result of its massive information campaign on the hazards and ill-effects of the use of prohibited drugs, there are now hundreds of users who voluntarily surrender for appropriate treatment and
