Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Creation of the Position of
Legislative Liaison Officer. - There is hereby
created one (1) position of Legislative Liaison
Officer under the supervision and control of the
Sangguniang Panlungsod of Quezon City.

SECTION 2. Appointment and Compensation. - Subject to Civil Service Law and Rules, the Legislative Liaison Officer shall be appointed by the City Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. He shall receive a salary, allowances and other emoluments equivalent to those being received by Assistant Department Heads of the City Government.

SECTION 3. <u>Powers and Duties</u>. - The Legislative Liaison Officer shall perform the following duties and functions:

a. Provides liaison services for the City Council, particularly with the Department of Local Government, the Congress of the Philippines, the national and local bureaucracies and non-governmental organizations;
