WHEREAS, the State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and is committed to protect their physical, moral, spiritual and intellectual well-being and to see to it that the young develop deep sense of nationalism and patriotism and be encouraged to get involve in public and civic affairs;

WHEREAS, as a modest contribution of the Quezon City Government in the pursuit and realization of the aforesaid aims, goals and objectives, the City Government fittingly established the Quezon City Youth Welfare Council in order to expand the mechanism and opportunity of administrative and technical development of the young and mold them towards spontaneous, solid and collective effort and responsibility in community-building;

WHEREAS, initially, under Executive Order No. 26 dated August 7, 1986, the subject office was directed to be and operated under the Office of the City Mayor, but under the City's 1991 Annual Executive Budget, the Quezon City Youth Welfare Council is listed under the Office of the City Vice Mayor;

WHEREAS, considering the development thrust, experience, training, exposure and manpower, complement of the Office of the City Mayor, it is generally perceived that the latter's Office is in the best operational position primarily to
