ORDINANCE

CREATING FIVE (5) PEOPLE'S LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARDS (PLEBs) ONE (1) EACH FOR DISTRICTS I, III AND IV, AND TWO (2) FOR DISTRICT II, CORRESPONDING TO THE FIVE (5) POLICE STATIONS OF THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT IN QUEZON CITY, AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, under Republic Act No. 6975, Section 43, it is prescribed that there shall be created in every city such number of People's Law Enforcement Boards (PLEBs) as may be necessary;

WHEREAS, said Act further provides that there shall be at least one (1) PLEB for each of the legislative districts in a city or at least one (1) PLEB for every five hundred (500) city police personnel;

WHEREAS, Quezon City has four (4) legislative districts, with five (5) police stations, one each at Districts I, III and IV, and two (2) at District II, all under the supervision of the Central Police District, and about two thousand sixty seven (2,067) city police personnel;

WHEREAS, an ideal ratio in terms of territorial and manpower composition would be to have at least one (1) PLEB for each of the five (5) police stations in Quezon City;
