



Ordinance No. NC- 211, S-91

ORDINANCE
PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOSITION OF PERMIT FEES,
SLAUGHTER FEES, POST-MORTEM FEES AND CORRAL
FEES OF ANIMALS IN QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The City is hereby providing
for the collection of certain fees as enumerated
herein.

SECTION 2. DEFINITION - the words and phra-
ses hereunder enumerated shall be interpreted
within the context it is indicated:

SLAUGHTER PERMIT - is a right or
permission granted by the Quezon
City Health Officer/Veterinarian
before any animal is slaughtered
for public or private consumption.

SLAUGHTER FEES - are impositions
in consideration for the use of
the facilities of the slaughter-
house maintained by the Quezon
City Government.

POST MORTEM FEES - are impositions
for the inspection of the carcass
or meat of slaughtered animals by
the City Health Officer/Veterinarian
in order to determine if the animals
are suffering from any disease or
abnormalities which render them
unfit for human consumption.

CORRAL FEES - are impositions
collected for animals which are
deposited or kept in a city corral
owned by the city government.
