ORDINANCE

CREATING THE ADMINISTRATIVE MANAGEMENT OFFICE UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, QUEZON CITY, FOR EFFICIENT, EFFECTIVE AND RESPONSIVE PUBLIC SERVICES, AND REPROGRAMMING THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION NINE HUNDRED THIRTY THREE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTY FOUR & 92/100 PESOS (\$\nu\$1,933,354.92) OUT OF ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR TO COVER THE NECESSARY FUNDING REQUIREMENTS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, Rule X, Sec. 2 of the Local Government Code Implementing Rules provides that any local government unit may adopt its own organizational structure and staffing pattern in order to organize, restructure and consolidate the functions of Offices to achieve maximum efficiency and effectiveness;

WHEREAS, as provided for in Article III, Sec. 2 (dd) of the Quezon City Chapter, the City Council has the power to establish, maintain and regulate city departments and prescribe the powers and duties thereof and readjust the same;

WHEREAS, the Office of the Mayor is the core of all departments/offices/units in the Quezon City Government, and the City Mayor who heads the same is the City's Chief Executive;

WHEREAS, the Administrative Division is a vital arm of the Office of the Mayor in the implementation/execution of its administrative policies, activities, achievments and/or projects in the service of its constituents, the national and local government and its agencies and the general public;

WHEREAS, in view of the city-wide scope of the functions, responsibilities and tasks of the Administrative Division in the Office of the Mayor, there is an urgent need to broaden its structure and to increase its personnel complement to enable it to cope with the ever-growing demands of the work for the delivery of efficient, effective and responsive public service;

WHEREAS, the existing Administrative Division should be upgraded into an Office to be thus called the Administrative Management Office to correspond to the degree and magnitude of functions and responsibilities it has to accomplish.
