ORDINANCE Numbered 2

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACTING MAYOR, QUEZON CITY, TO RENT THE MANILA HEIGHTS HOSPITAL AND PREMISES FOR OFFICES, COURTROOM AND JAIL AND QUARTERS FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF QUEZON CITY.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City:

SECTION 1.- The Acting Mayor of Quezon City is hereby authorized to rent the property known as the "Manila Heights Hospital" situated in Quezon City, excluding the residence of Dr. Valentin M. Azeala and the premises immediately adjoining same, for offices, court room and jail and quarters for certain employees of Quezon City, from November first, nineteen hundred and thirty-nine to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and forty, at the monthly rate of Three hundred and twenty-five Pesos with the understanding that Quezon City will undertake such alterations and repairs as may be necessary or desirable at its expense during the period of lease, and with an option to renew the contract of lease at the beginning of each fiscal year under the same terms and conditions, provided that if the property is not required for any fiscal year, an advance notice of two months shall be given the owner before the beginning of such fiscal year.

SEC. 2.- This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
