ORDINANCE Numbered 8.

ORDINANCE PUNISHING CERTAIN IMMORAL ACTS.

It ordained by the City Council of Quezon City,

SECTION 1. Indecent Acts.- No person shall be or
on or upon any street, or place open to public
any indecent or lewd dress, or shall make any
exposure of his or her person, or be guilty
of any lewd, obscene, or filthy act, or any lewd,
immoral, or insulting conduct, language, or
or shall exhibit, circulate, distribute, sell,
expose for sale, or give or deliver to another,
the same to be done, any lewd, indecent, or ob-
scene picture, pamphlet, card, cut, paper, writ-
ing, cast, figure, or any other thing; or shall
perform, or cause or allow to be exhibited
in or upon any house, building, lot, or
land or occupied by him, or under his manage-
ment, any lewd, indecent, or immoral play
presentation.

SECTION 2. Obscene advertising.- It shall be unlaw-
ful to post any bill, placard, or other advertisement
or pictures or illustrations of an obscene or
immoral character.

SECTION 3. Intoxication.- No person shall be drunk
or in a drunken, boisterous or rude manner in
any place, or place open to public view; or
be intoxicated, or behave in a drunken,
boisterous or rude manner in any place or premise
to the annoyance of another person.

SECTION 4. Vagrancy.- Any person who has no vocation,
support and lives without lawful emp-
loyment; who keeps a house of public gaming or gamb-
ling; or acts as pimp or procurer;
or who is a gambler or prostitute; or who
maintains himself by gambling.

SEC. 5. Drumming up business for undertakers.- It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to drum up business or patronage for any funeral parlor or undertaking establishment in hospitals, sanatoriums, asylums, reformatories, prisons, and other public places.

SEC. 6. Permitting drumming up business for undertakers; reports to police.- It shall be unlawful for any person owning or managing any of the said hospitals, sanatoriums, and other public places knowingly to permit any of said places to be used by any person or persons for drumming up the said business. It shall be the duty of the director or person in charge of any hospital, sanatorium, or other public place to report to the police any person or persons found violating the last preceding section.

SEC. 7. Minors, prohibitions as to.- (a) Purchases from, by second-hand dealers: No dealer in second-hand articles or keeper of a junk shop shall purchase goods, articles, or thing whatsoever, except rags and waste paper, from any minor under the age of fifteen years.

~~(b) Employment by pawnbrokers: No person who keeps or operates billiard or pool tables or maintains billiard or pool rooms shall permit or allow any minor under the age of eighteen years to play thereon or use such tables, or to be or remain in or frequent said~~

(b) Employment by pawnbrokers: No pawnbroker shall employ or employ any person under the age of fifteen years to take or receive any article or thing in pledge or

(c) Frequenting of pool rooms: No person who keeps or operates billiard or pool tables or maintains billiard or pool rooms shall permit or allow any minor under the age of eighteen years to play thereon or use such tables, or to be or remain in or frequent said

SEC. 8. Penalty for violation. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine not more than two hundred pesos or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both, in the discretion of the court.

SEC. 9. This Ordinance shall take effect on its passage.
