ORDINANCE Numbered 13.

ANNE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE NEEDS OF THE CITY OF QUEZON CITY IN CONNECTION WITH THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF ALL GARBAGE, REFUSE, AND THE CONTENTS OF CLOSETS, CESSPOOLS, AND OTHER OFFENSIVE AND DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES WITHIN THE QUEZON CITY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, by Section 16(b) of Commonwealth Act No. 502, the City Engineer of Quezon City is charged with the duty to collect and dispose of all garbage, refuse, contents of closets and cesspools and all other offensive and dangerous substances within the said city;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid City Engineer invited the attention of the City Council to the necessity of immediately undertaking this work in the interest of the health and convenience of the inhabitants of the city;

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City,

SECTION 1.- The sum of Ten Thousand Pesos (\$10,000) or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the sum made available under Section 4 of Commonwealth Act No. 502, for the expenses of collection and disposal of all garbage, refuse, the contents of closets, cesspools, and all other offensive and dangerous substances within Quezon City, during the period from October 1, 1939 to June 30, 1940, as follows:

1. For purchase of equipments -
2 - 2 1/2 trucks, complete, with appropriate bodies ----- \$5,400.00
2. For salaries of personnel -
2 drivers @ \$40.00 a month each 560.00
6 garbage men @ \$30.00 a month each ----- 1,260.00
3. For operating expenses -
Fuel, lubrication, and repair services ----- 2,720.00
- Total expenses ----- \$9,640.00

SEC. 2.- Any unappropriated balance of all the appropriations herein made on June 30, 1940, shall revert to the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the City Treasury.

SEC. 3.- This ordinance shall take effect on its passage.
