ORDINANCE Numbered 17.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P5,500.00) FOR THE NECESSARY EXPENSES FOR THE CONTROL OF MALARIA IN QUEZON CITY.

WISCONSAS, Councilor Susebio D. Aguilar, in his capacity as Director of Health, informed the Council of the need for additional allotment for malaria control in Quezon City:

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. The sum of P5,500.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the sum made available under Section 4 of Commonwealth Act No. 502, for the expenses of effectively controlling malaria in the City.

SEC. 2. The sum set aside in this Ordinance shall be expended solely for the specific purpose for which appropriated, and for no other.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on its passage.
