ORDINANCE Numbered 21.

AN ORDINANCE CREATING ONE POSITION OF PATROLMAN-PHOTOGRAPHER IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH COMPENSATION AT THE RATE OF P900.00 PER ANNUM AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF THE NECESSARY APPARATUS AND SUPPLIES FOR THE PURPOSE, NOT EXCEEDING P250.00.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police recommended the creation in his department of one position of patrolman-photographer with compensation at the rate of P900.00 per annum and the purchase of the necessary apparatus and supplies for the purpose;

WHEREAS, this Council realizes the necessity thereof;

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. One position of patrolman-photographer with compensation at the rate of P900.00 per annum, is hereby created.

SEC. 2. For this purpose, the sum of P900.00 and the sum of P250.00 for the purchase of the necessary apparatus and supplies from the salary savings realized in the Police Department, are hereby reverted.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on its passage.
