ORDINANCE Numbered 23.

AN ORDINANCE CREATING ONE POSITION OF CEMETERY CARE-TAKER WITH COMPENSATION AT THE RATE OF P10.00 A MONTH AND APPROPRIATING FUND THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the City Health Officer reported to this Council that the administration of the Baranca Cemetery which used to be within the jurisdiction of the municipality of Mariquina, was transferred by the latter municipality to the Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the then caretaker of the said cemetery has continued to perform his duties;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid City Health Officer recommended the creation of one position of cemetery caretaker with compensation at the rate of P10.00 a month, from January 1, 1940 to June 30 of the same year;

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. One position of caretaker, Baranca Cemetery, with compensation at the rate of P10.00 a month, is hereby created, effective January 1, 1940.

SEC. 2. For this purpose, the sum of Sixty Pesos (P60.00) is hereby appropriated out of the sum made available under Section 4 of Commonwealth Act No. 502.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on its passage.
