ORDINANCE Numbered 35.

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING THE HOURS OF OPERATION OF BOWLING ALLEYS, BILLIARD AND POOL HALLS, OR OTHER PLACES OF AMUSEMENTS, AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR ITS VIOLATION.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. Hours permitted.- No person or persons, club or corporation maintaining or operating bowling alleys, billiard or pool halls or other places of amusements within the limits of Quezon City, shall open or operate the same except during the time from eight a.m. to one a.m. of the day following.

SEC. 2. Penalty for violation.- Any violation of the provision of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than two hundred pesos or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both, such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

SEC. 3. Effectivity.- This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
