ORDINANCE Numbered 36.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION OF BIRTH.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City,  
that:

Section 1. Birth certificates; for whom issued, and form.-  
Birth certificates for children of less than one year of age,  
shall be issued gratis, which certificate shall be in the fol-  
lowing form:

Sec. 2. Birth certificates; how and when furnished.-  
That for the purpose above-mentioned, upon the presentation of  
a birth certificate, the person presenting the same should be  
asked by the official concerned if he or she desires to be fur-  
nished with a copy of the aforesaid certificate and in the af-  
firmative case, the same must be issued.

Sec. 3. Birth certificate; Form of; and fee.- Certifi-  
cates of births for children over the age of One (1) year shall  
be issued in Municipal Form No. 102 (Revised 1939) and for the  
issuance of the same, a fee of ONE (P1.00) PESO shall be charged  
for each.

Sec. 4. Effectivity.- This Ordinance shall take effect  
upon its passage.
