ORDINANCE Numbered 39.

AN ORDINANCE CLARIFYING ORDINANCE NUMBERED 20, RELATIVE TO THE MANUFACTURE, SALE AND EXPLOSION OF FIRECRACKERS, SKYROCKETS AND OTHER SIMILAR FIREWORKS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 20, current series, has been misinterpreted in some quarters as not including the firing of skyrockets and other like fireworks; and WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that said Ordinance be amended and clarified.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

Section 1. Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 20, current series, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. Prohibition.- It shall be unlawful for any person to manufacture or cause to be manufactured, sell or cause to be sold, firecrackers, skyrockets or any other kind or class of fireworks within the limits of Quezon City."

"SEC. 2. It shall, likewise, be unlawful for any person to light, explode or fire or cause to be lighted, exploded or fired, firecrackers, skyrockets or any other kind or class of fireworks: Provided, That the City Mayor may, upon application duly filed therefor, permit on special occasions the lighting, display and exhibition of fireworks, commonly known as "fuegos artificiales", under such conditions as he may fix with a view to avoiding danger to persons or property at or about the place where such fireworks will be displayed, exhibited or lighted."

SEC. 3. Effectivity.- This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
