ORDINANCE Numbered 53

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE "C" UNDER THE TITLE  
"MARKET FEES" OF SECTION 31 OF ORDINANCE NO. 10  
OF QUEZON CITY.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon  
City that:

SECTION 1. The schedule of market fees under  
Schedule "C" Section 31 of Ordinance No. 10, Quezon  
City, should be amended so as to read as follows:

Sellers of meat	.30	(daily)
Sellers of fresh fishes, shrimps, crabs, and other sea food	.80	per square meter or fraction thereof.
Sellers of dried fish	.15	
Sellers of poultry placed in cages	.30	"
Sellers of poultry not in cages, each	.02	"
Sellers of vegetables	.05	"
Sellers of fruits and the like	.05	"
Sellers of cooked foods	.10	"
Sellers of sari-sari (costaltrajes)	.10	"
Sellers of ice-cream or mango con hielo	.10	"
Sellers of dry goods (mercaderias)	.10	"
Sellers of rice, each	.10	"

"All vendors or occupants of each stall in the  
market shall pay the above fees before selling their  
commodities, provided, however, that in those places  
where there are no permanently established markets the  
vendors or occupants of stalls shall pay P.10 per  
square meter or fraction thereof.

"No vendors shall be allowed to sell or barter any  
of the above named commodities in public streets and a  
radius of 100 meters from the market premises unless  
payment of the fees herein proscribed is first made.

"Market tickets are intransferable."

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect imme-  
diately upon approval.
